


Also riding high on a wave of emotion last week were two of our Boys' Football teams who competed in their respective county finals.





Notice of Major Roadworks in St Austell

We would like to make the Penrice community aware of major resurfacing work to improve road safety is taking place on the A391 in St Austell during May.

Diversions will be set up while the North East Distributor road is shut from May 6 to 30 for the essential works to be carried out.

Let's work together to support each student's learning journey. We look forward to seeing you there! Appointments can be booked via the online system (details have been emailed to parents/carers).




