## NEW MFL HOME-LEARNING PLATFORM

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to let you know that Penrice Academy has recently launched a subscription to **This is School**, a brand-new digital platform to support language learning both in lessons and at home.

With thousands of interactive activities, engaging videos, and vocabulary tools, this resource is designed to make learning feel like an adventure while helping students develop both confidence and progress in their languages. Teachers can also track how much time students spend on the platform, which allows us to monitor home-learning in a supportive way. Please note that students are not expected to complete games or challenges all in one sitting - this is an ongoing task, and teachers will provide alternative vocabulary activities if the games feel too fast.

### PILOT TESTING THANK YOU

We would like to thank those students and parents who have reached out to us regarding some of the initial challenges with logging in, and for the constructive feedback you have shared. We have already fed this back to the company and have been working closely with them to improve the experience.

### HOW TO LOG IN

When logging in, it is important that students enter their school details directly - logging in via Google will not work. If a password is forgotten, it can be reset; however, please remind your child to check their junk folder as the reset email often goes there.


