

Year 11 Geography and History Field Trips



Geography students ventured to Fistral Beach, Newquay, where they explored coastal processes in action - collecting data, conducting beach profiling, analysing sediment, and evaluating coastal management strategies.

Meanwhile, our History students journeyed to Pendennis Castle, Falmouth, diving into Tudor history as part of their Early Elizabethan England GCSE topic. They traced Sir Francis Drake's global voyage and examined the castle's defence tactics from the 16th century.

- 3rd Place – River (7AS)


Year 8 Update

Polite Reminders - Coats and Drinks Bottles

As the seasons shift and the weather becomes cooler, we kindly ask that you remind your child to bring a coat to school for lesson changeovers. Additionally, please ensure they have a drinks bottle with them, as we do not have spare bottles available on site.



Scheduled Roadworks Near Penrice Academy

Wales and West Utilities, in partnership with Cornwall Council, will be carrying out essential gas pipe replacement works on Polmear Road, St Austell, starting Wednesday 8th October through to Christmas.

The work will happen in two phases, each lasting about 6 weeks.

Phase One: Multiway traffic lights will be in place at the junction of Cromwell Road, Porthpean Road, and Polmear Road.

Phase Two: Multiway traffic lights will be installed around the roundabout at Polmear Road,

Charlestown Road, Mount Charles Road, and Holmbush Road.

These improvements are part of a long-term, multi-million-pound investment programme to replace old metal gas pipes near buildings with safer, durable plastic ones, helping ensure the safety and reliability of gas supply across the region.

Thank you for your understanding as this vital work takes place. Please plan accordingly for possible delays around school drop-off and pick-up times.




