

July 2026 – Y11 Results Day

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we near results day for the Class of 2026, we wanted to provide some further information to support you and your child.

Results will be issued to students on **Thursday 20th August** in school **between 9:00am and 11:00am**. We very much look forward to seeing our students then. Parents are warmly invited to attend as well.

There will be lots of staff on hand to support and guide our students towards their next steps when they receive their results. We would encourage students to open their results with us in school, so they can receive any support they require.

What if my child cannot attend in person?

If students are unable to collect results in person, please email Jo Skyba (Exams Officer) jskyba@penrice.celtrust.org to arrange for results to be emailed to you. Requests must be made by 9am on Wednesday 19th August (the day prior to results day) otherwise we cannot guarantee results will be received on results day.

Please note that we are unable to release results to anyone other than the candidate, unless we have prior written permission to do so.

What can we do if a result is lower than we had hoped for?

As with any year, some students will get a result that is lower than they would have hoped for. If this is the case, there will be members of staff present at results day to help and support your child through their next steps.

The first thing to do will be to contact the college or sixth form that your child has applied to and see how their results affect their acceptance onto their chosen course.

Students may appeal their grades and request a review of marking. To begin this process, we first need the student's permission to request a copy of their exam script. Once received, the subject teacher can review it and advise whether a remark is worthwhile, including how close the original mark was to the next grade boundary.

Please be aware that there is a fee charged by the exam boards for each individual paper for appeals, and grades can go down as well as up.

Access to Exam Scripts

On results day, we will be asking students to give the school permission to access their exam scripts when they collect their results. This will allow us to use their scripts to support the training of our staff and students in future years. We thank our students in advance for their support.

The result slips provided on results day are not GCSE certificates. We will announce a date early next academic year for students to come and collect their certificates. These are important documents and may be requested by future employers as proof of any qualifications.
