Please complete the following steps to ensure you get your preferred options for CEW 2018.

- 1. Speak to your Parent / Carer about what activity you would like to do.**
- 2. At 8am on Monday 27th November, the Google Doc Form will go live which you can access below.**

Complete the Google Doc Form where you will be asked to select your preferred activity plus two reserve activities; if your preferred option does not appear on the Google Doc Form then it means that all spaces have already been taken and you will need to choose another activity.

Places are limited and allocated on a first come, first served basis via the Google Doc Form below.

This link will be available from 8am on Monday 27th November.

- 3. You must select an activity and two reserve activities. These reserve lists will only be used if a space becomes available on an activity that may have already been full when you completed the Google Doc Form. Spaces will be allocated to students in preference of the time the Google Doc Form was completed.**
- 4. Where multiple users are completing forms simultaneously the option to sign up for an activity may still show but places may have already been allocated. This is due to the fact that until final submission of the Google Doc available places will still appear. If this occurs we will allocate places based on the timestamp date on the google doc submission and contact parents/carers. Reserve options will be allocated in this situation.**
- 5. The school will then set up a ParentPay link on your account for you to make payment for your CEW activity. This payment option will be set up the week beginning 4th December 2017.**
- 6. A £10 deposit will secure your place (excluding Harry Potter Week and Arts, Craft and Creative Week, Mixed Arts Week, The Great Penrice Bake Off which are £5 (total cost) and full payment will be required at this time). You may also make full payment for your activity at this time if you wish. The deposit will need to be paid by 5th January 2018.**
- 7. Payments for residential trips to Barton Hall (Year 8 and 9 only) and London trips (Year 9 only) require deposits of £80 (Barton Hall) or £100 (London) to be paid at this time.**
- 8. If your activity is free, your place will be allocated from the Google Doc Form.**
- 9. Full payments for CEW activities will need to be received via ParentPay by Friday 23rd March 2018.**
- 10. Penrice Academy reserves the right to make the final decision as to whether an activity is appropriate for an individual student.**





We stay in a former chateau set in impressive grounds, with its own outdoor heated pool and great facilities, just outside Paris.


