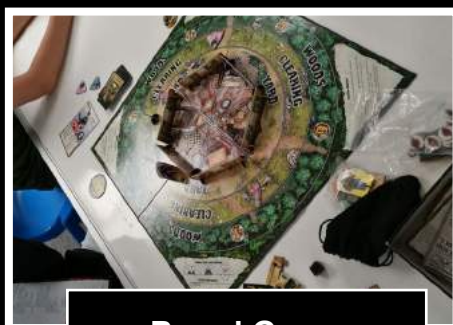
**Badminton**

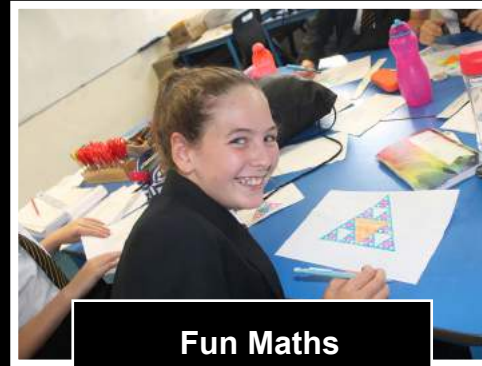

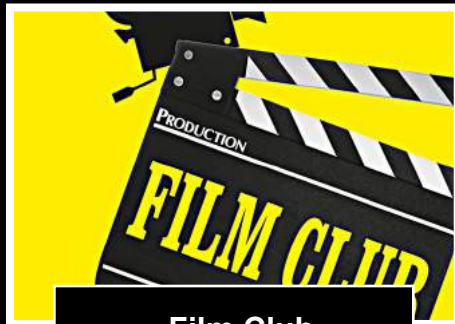
**Girls Football**

Discover what's available for you as you approach your A Levels in **H7**. Spend time exploring a range of A Level topics and developing the skills essential for success.

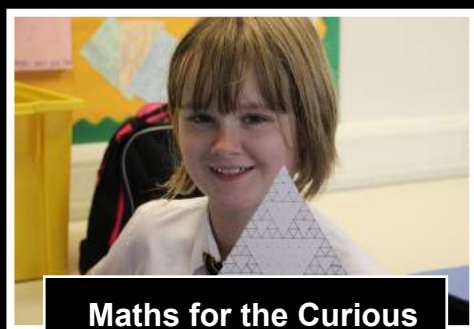
