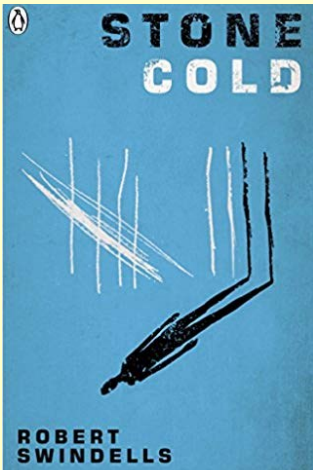

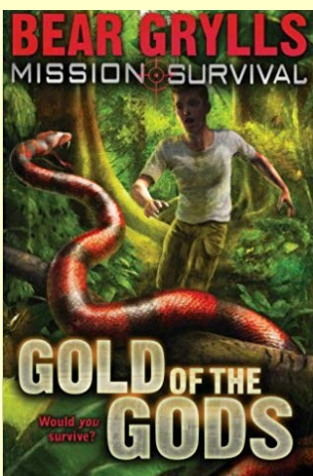

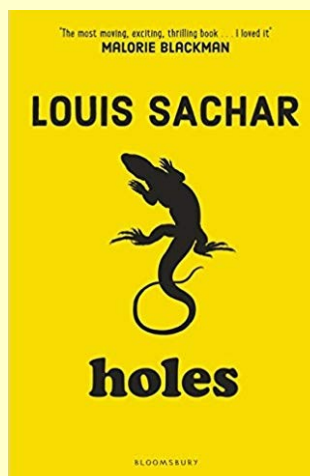
MISSION SURVIVAL

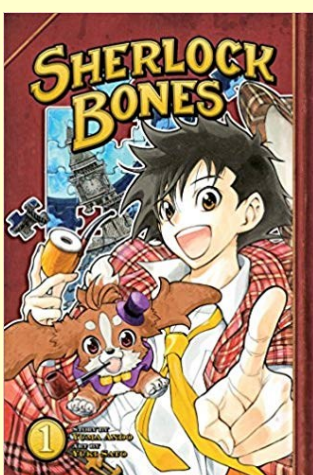


HOLES Louis Sachar

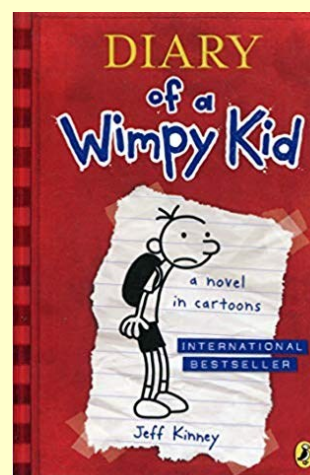
