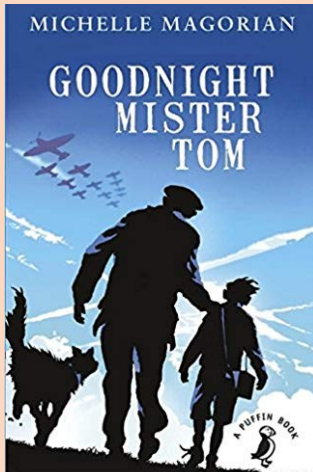

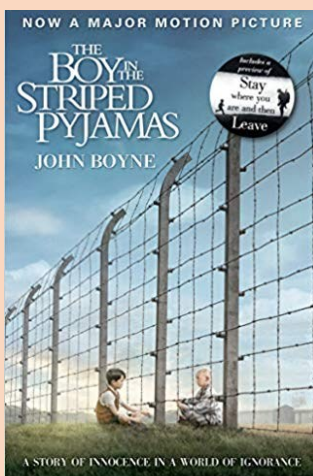


A HORSE CALLED

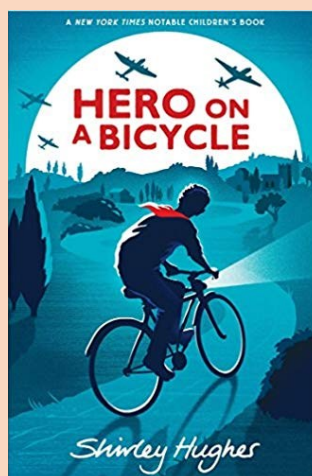


THE BOY IN THE STRIPED PYJAMAS

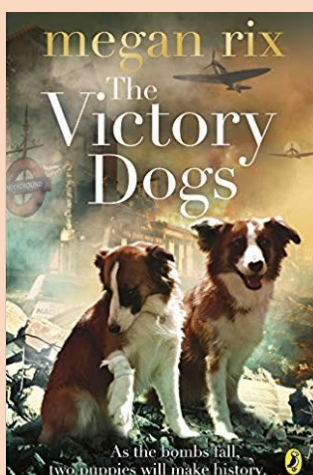


HERO ON A BICYCLE

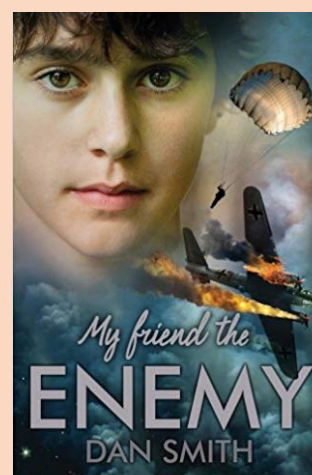


VICTORY DOGS
