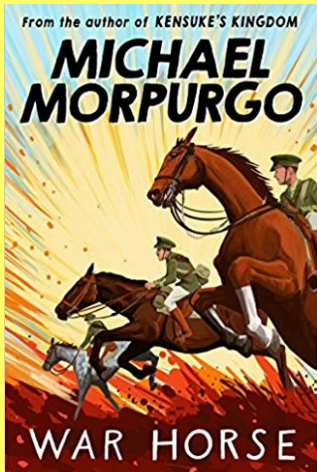

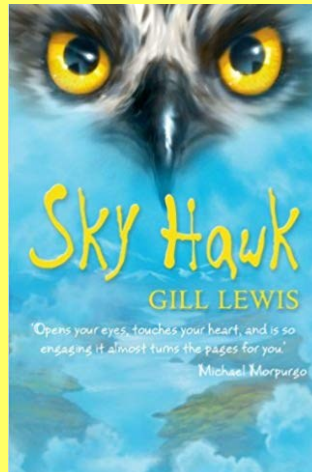


WAR HORSE

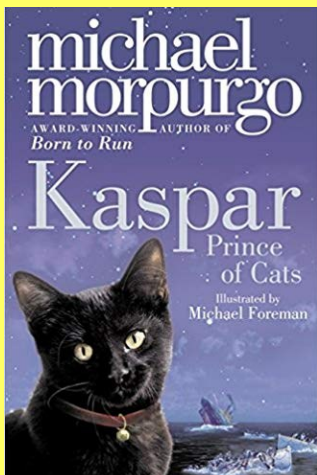


SKY HAWK Gill Lewis

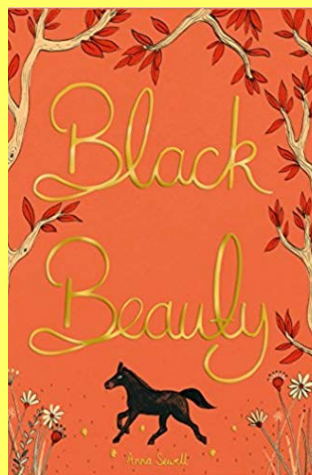
KASPAR PRINCE OF

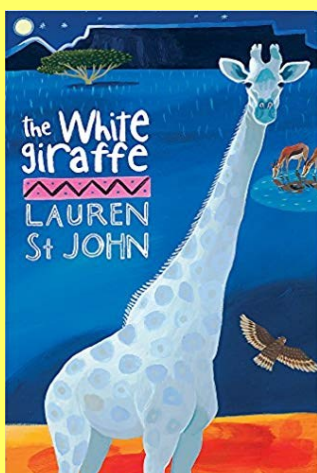


BLACK BEAUTY

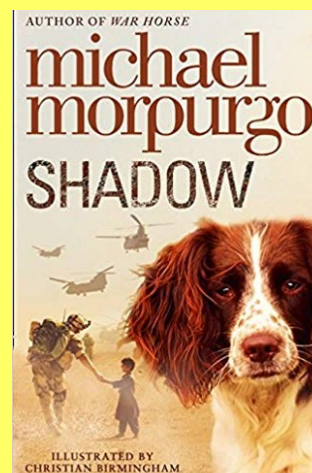


THE WHITE GIRAFFE
