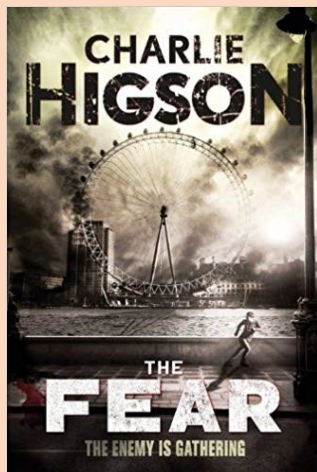

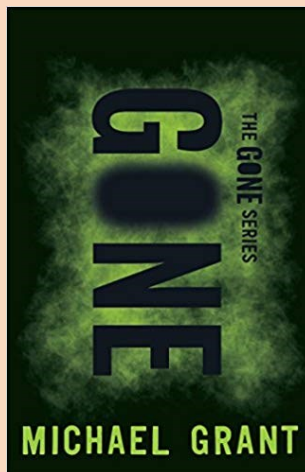


THE ENEMY (series)

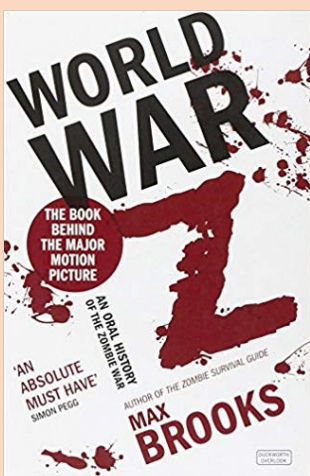


GONE (series)

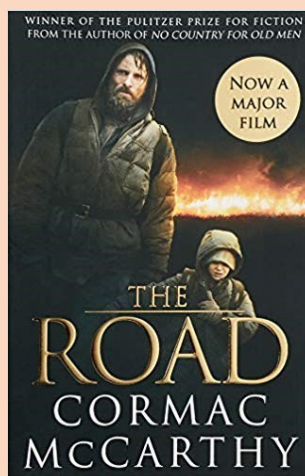

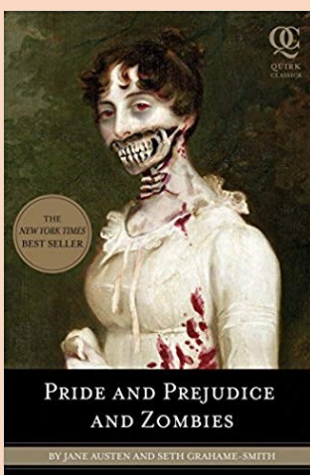
