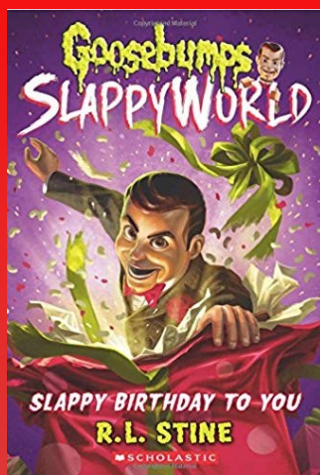

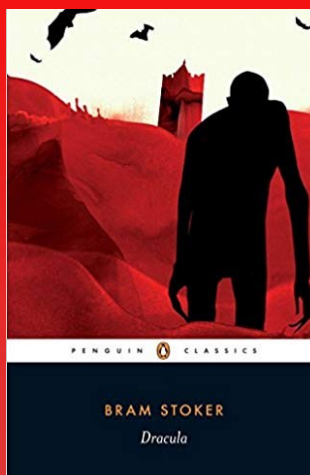


GOOSEBUMPS (series)

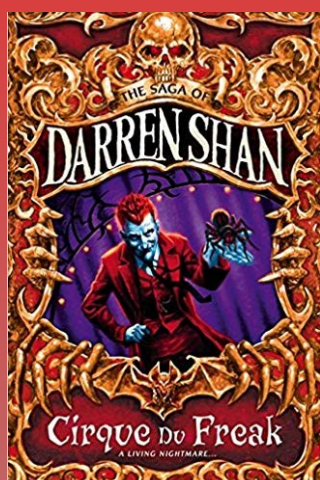


DRACULA

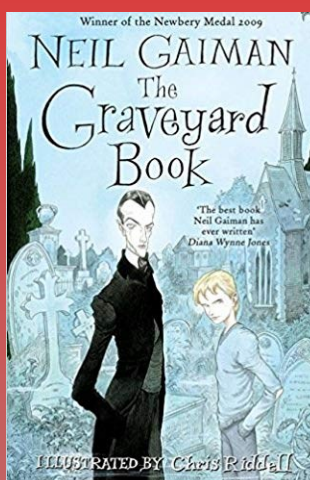


VAMPIRE (series)

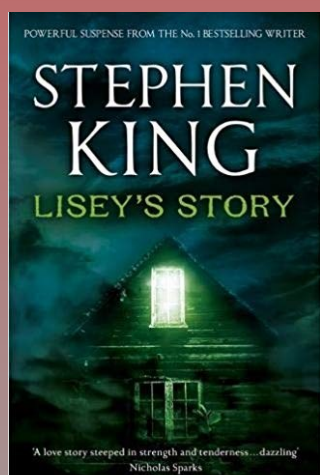
THE GRAVEYARD

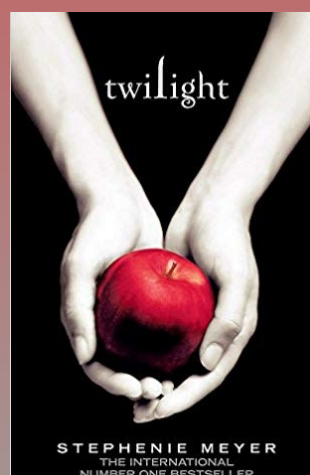
LISEY'S STORY
