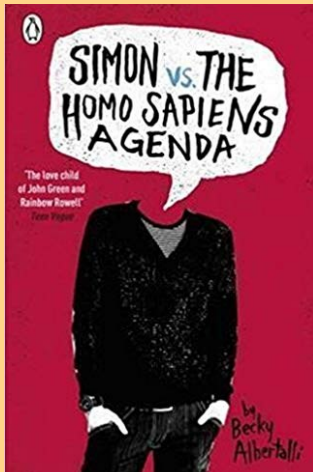

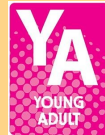
SIMON VS. THE HOMO SAPIENS

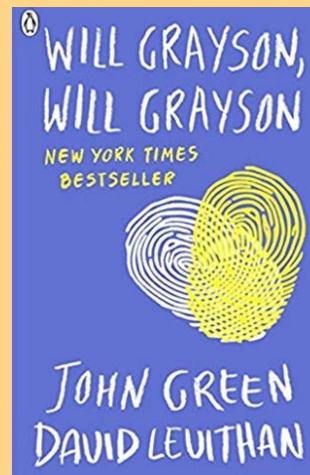
