Caring for a child from birth to 5 years	Autumn Term and Spring Term	Students will be recapping on the pre-conceptual, contraception and antenatal and postnatal needs of a child and mum from previous years. They will then continue to observe and analyse how children grow and develop from birth to 5 years. They will consider the needs of a child over this period and how parents/carers can support and hinder this development. This element will cover their case study of a child whilst also overlapping with their exam module. Students will gain first hand experience of planning, providing and evaluating activities and behaviours needed to provide positive development experiences for young children.
