What is character?	Autumn Term 1	<p>Students will begin to explore the meaning of <i>character</i>, being introduced to the four character virtues of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Intellectual</li> <li>2. Moral</li> <li>3. Civic</li> <li>4. Performance</li> </ol> <p>Students will then learn to recognise how the arts is an avenue for exploring and developing character, identifying how participation in the arts provide opportunities for character development.</p>	Understanding the four character virtues gives a basis to then look in greater detail and specific features of our character. Artist Research	Autumn Term 2	Students will learn the ways in which some artists demonstrate the character traits of service, justice, determination, and citizenship. They will recognise the philanthropic acts that some artists participate in alongside their art, and how the public nature of their role provides them a platform to demonstrate these character traits.	Recognising how others demonstrate these character traits will provide opportunities for students to apply these actions to their own lives.	All Arts subjects
Exploring the arts	Spring Term 1	Students will learn about the character traits of civility, gratitude, and respect, considering how these have been demonstrated in their recent arts event participation. They will learn how to share arts experiences and how to demonstrate the character traits of civility, confidence, neighbourliness, and resilience.	These character traits are the basis of service and duty and allow students to understand how to demonstrate these.	All Arts subjects
What is character?	Spring Term 2	Students will explore character through music and art, first learning about protest songs and their role in history as a form of peaceful protest. Students will also learn how to create art that has purpose, demonstrating to others how they can show traits of compassion, courage, integrity and service.	Appreciating the arts as a tool for communicating with others will allow them to further consider how they will explore the arts in their Drama, Music and Art lessons.	All Arts subjects
Arts skill share	Summer Term	In sharing skills, students will learn how to demonstrate autonomy, critical thinking, volunteering, and reflection. They will learn how to confidently share a skill with others and learn to appreciate the value of sharing skills and experiences with others.
