How are the summary grades determined?

Attendance – Attendance at school is essential to students developing as well rounded individuals and their academic achievement.

Merits – Students earn merits when they demonstrate one of our school values of Pride, Respect or Success. **Y7 – 9** **Y10 & 11**

Behaviour Points – Students are given behaviour points when they don't demonstrate the values of the school community.

Homework – Completing homework supports students in embedding the knowledge and skills they learn in lessons

Ready to learn – Students get scored each lesson for the engagement with learning on a score of 1 (Support Req.) to 5 (Exceptional). The average they score across all their subjects is compared to the year group, this rank creates their overall grading.

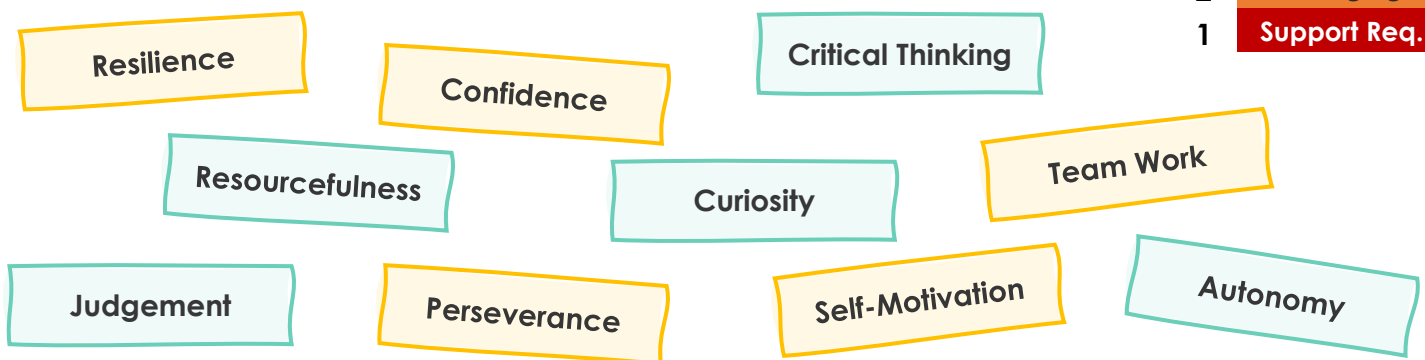
