#### What is my child learning about this term?

English	analysis of language, structure and evaluation of methods.  Students will analyse and compare of more poems from the Anthology based on internal conflict.
Maths	Sequences, Trigonometry, Angles and Pythagoras
Science	Forces (Combined) or Waves (Triple) & Magnetism - Students will learn all about forces and how they interact with objects and the effect on the objects motion. Students will also apply Newton's laws of motion to different scenarios such as skydivers. Triple students study waves.
History	<b>The USA, 1954-75 -</b> We now begin looking at our second topic, the Vietnam War, and how and why American involvement increased in the 1950s and early 1960s, through the rules of Eisenhower, Kennedy and Johnson. We focus on USA and VC tactics, and the impacts this had on the wider war.
Geography	Geography: Living World (Hot Deserts): Students will learn how hot desert environments form, their location and characteristics. The Mojave Desert is taught, and students will learn the opportunities and challenges in this extreme environment. Desertification and climate change are taught in the Sahel region of Africa.
French / Spanish	<b>Moving ahead -</b> Throughout the term, we revisit and revise all topics taught to date, work with model answers and complete a wide variety of exam style questions. Through guided over-to-you activities, students reflect on what went well in their PPEs and identify their next steps as we move towards year 11.
CLASS	Addressing extremism and radicalisation Community cohesion and challenging extremism Religion and Worldviews - Families and gender equality.
