Remembrance Ceremony

Today in school at 11am, the school fell silent as we showed our respects, remembering the service and sacrifice of the Armed Forces community from the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth. We will remember them.

Students from all year groups and a variety of organisations – from Scouts and Guides to Army and Sea Cadets – gathered in The Square to pay their respects to service men and women lost in combat around the world, dressed in full uniform.

Remembrance Day coincided with UK Parliament Week 2023. In light of this, all students have

been learning about the UK's democratic voting process that we have fought so hard to protect over many decades. Tutor groups discussed the eligible voting age, ways to vote, how long UK governments have in power and information found in party manifestos. Students were then invited to cast a vote into a ballot box for their preferred party based on current manifestos in a school-wide mock election.

A list of all available sports clubs is available at the end of this Parent Update to summarise everything that is on offer. Please ask your child to speak to a PE teacher if they would like to get involved.





SPACE is a new **free** programme for **any parent or carer** who wants to better understand and support their children's emotions, as well as their own.

This face-to-face programme will cover:

- Understanding what is meant by a Trauma Informed approach
- Understanding toxic stress and the flight/fight response
- Practical approaches to support children to regulate their emotions
- Healthy coping strategies for dealing with stress

- Managing different emotions
- Understanding behaviour
- Building resilience in ourselves and our children
- Adopting appropriate expectations of children
- Enhancing your ability to provide nurturing care
